

Read-and-Say-Something

This strategy is effective for difficult materials. Rather than letting students struggle with the meaning alone, have them work with a partner so they can grapple with meaning together.

A small group of students alternate reading a paragraph or section. The group leader begins by reading, and then the student to the right of the leader makes a comment relative to the content. Each student in the group makes a comment. Then, the process continues with the student to the right of the leader reading aloud.
